PURPOSE:

To outline the job duties or assignments of a Deputy Fire Chief within the Winsted Fire Department.

POLICY:

It will be the policy of the Winsted Fire Department that a Deputy Fire Chief have the proper skills, knowledge and certifications to perform the jobs and duties that include supervising and participating in activities of Interior and Exterior Firefighters.

POSITION SUMMARY:

The Winsted Fire Department's Deputy Fire Chief supports the Assistant Fire Chief as a senior leader within the Department. The Deputy Chief supports administrative and operational functions within the Winsted Fire Department, as directed by the Assistant Fire Chief. In the absence of the Fire Chief and Assistant Chief, the Deputy Chief assumes full command and responsibility for all departmental operations.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Assists the Fire Chief and Assistant Chief with the overall leadership and management of the department.

Acts in the capacity of the Fire Chief or Assistant Chief when delegated or in their absence.

Responds to emergency incidents, often in a command role, and ensures scene safety, coordination, and accountability.


Serves as a mentor and manages the performance and development of company officers and firefighters.

Helps develop, implement, and enforce departmental policies, standard operating guidelines (SOGs), and protocols.

As directed by the Assistant Chief/Training Officer, coordinate training programs and ensure compliance with local, state, and national standards.

Assists in planning for capital needs, resource replacement, and strategic growth.

At the direction of the Assistant Chief, manages resources (apparatus, equipment, personnel, etc.) for the Department.

Minimum of 5-8 years of fire service experience with at least 2 years in a supervisory or officer role.

Certified Fire Officer 1 and Fire Service Instructor 1 (Fire Officer 2 and Fire Service Instructor 2 preferred).

Valid driver's license: emergency vehicle operation training (EVOC) preferred.

NIMS/ICS training (ICS 100, 200, 700, 800 preferred).

Demonstrated leadership ability and effective communication skills.

Strong knowledge of fire suppression, rescue operations, and emergency incident management


Experience in managing volunteers or leading in a volunteer fire department environment.

Familiarity with operational functions such as operational readiness, resource management, and response initiatives.
